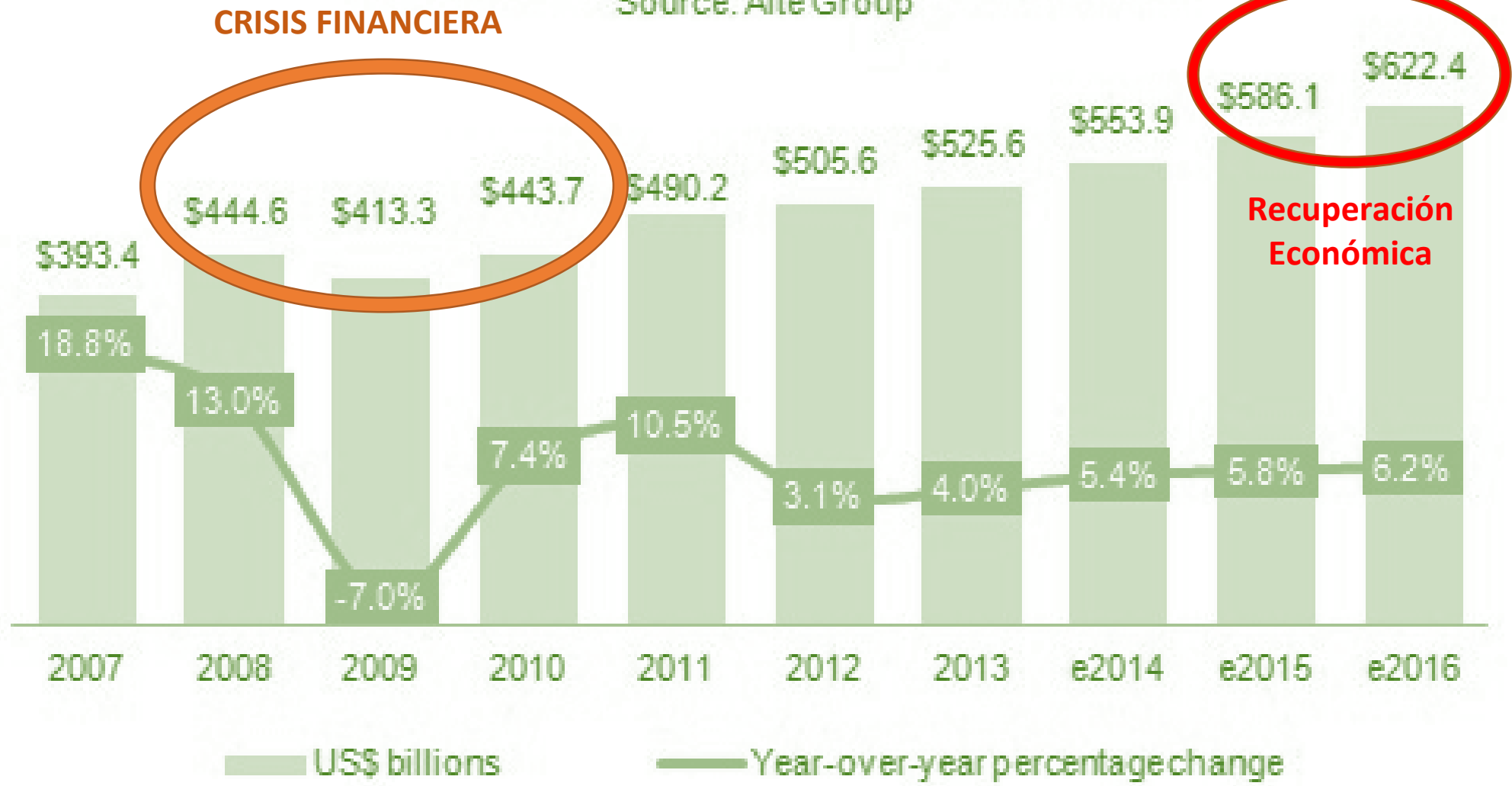

The map shows the value of the 10 largest remittance corridors sent home by migrants in 2016 for each of the world's 200+ countries.

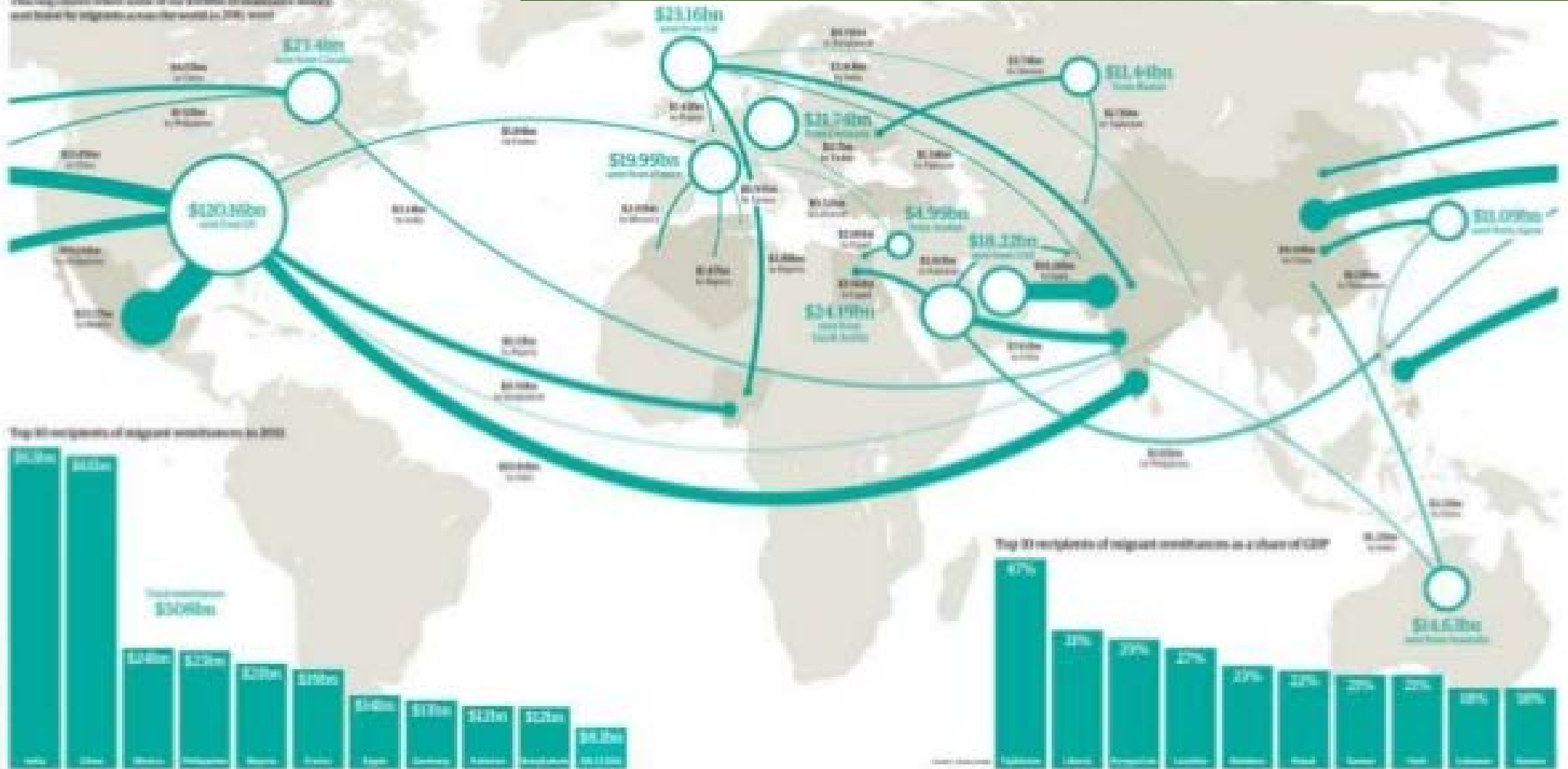
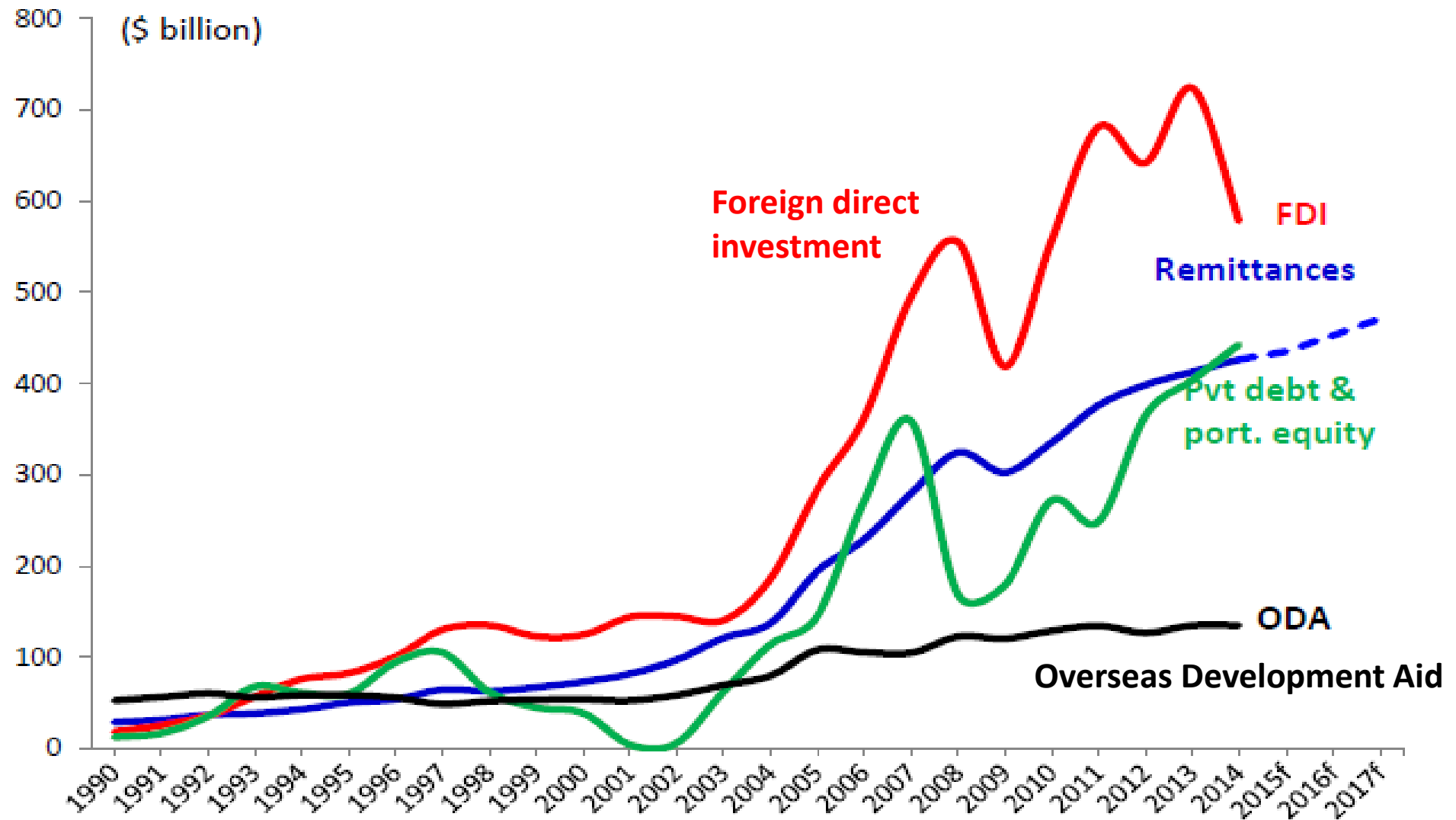
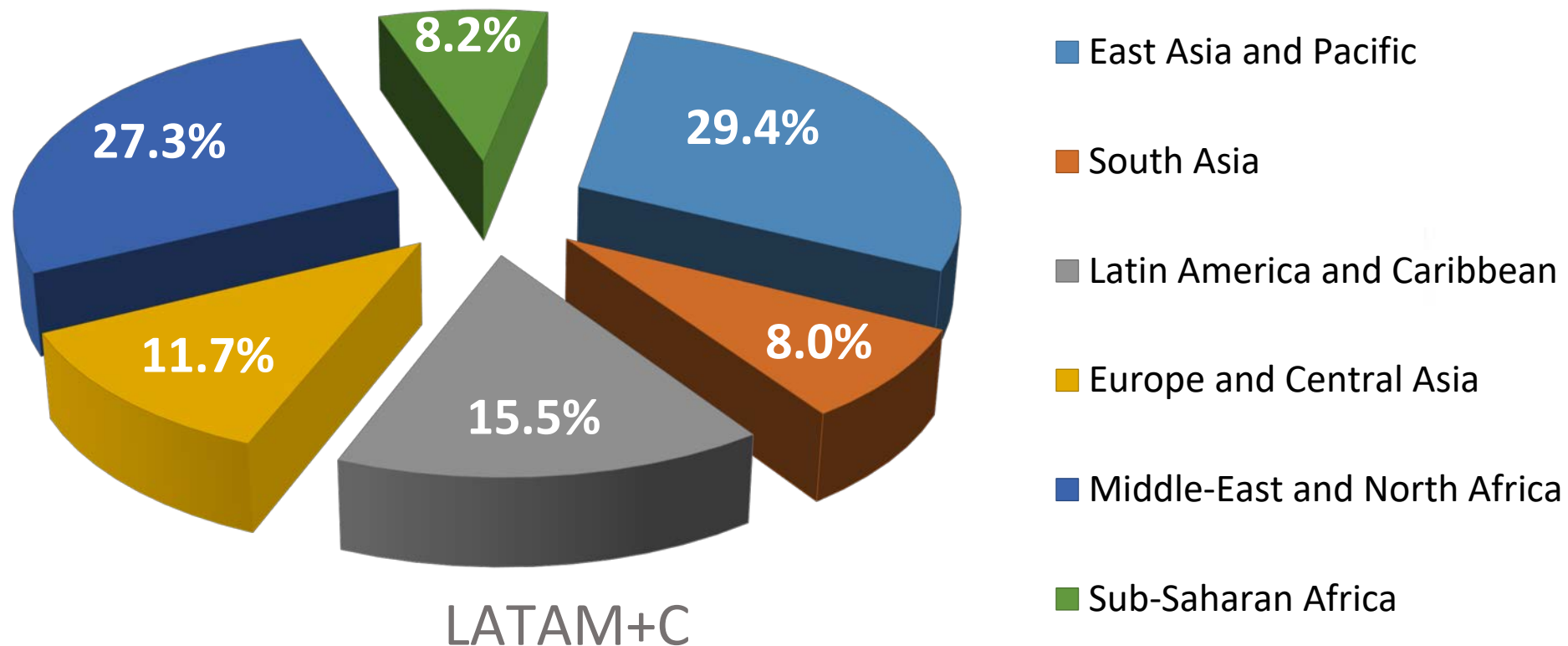


Figure 1: Remittance flows are larger than ODA, and more stable than private capital flows

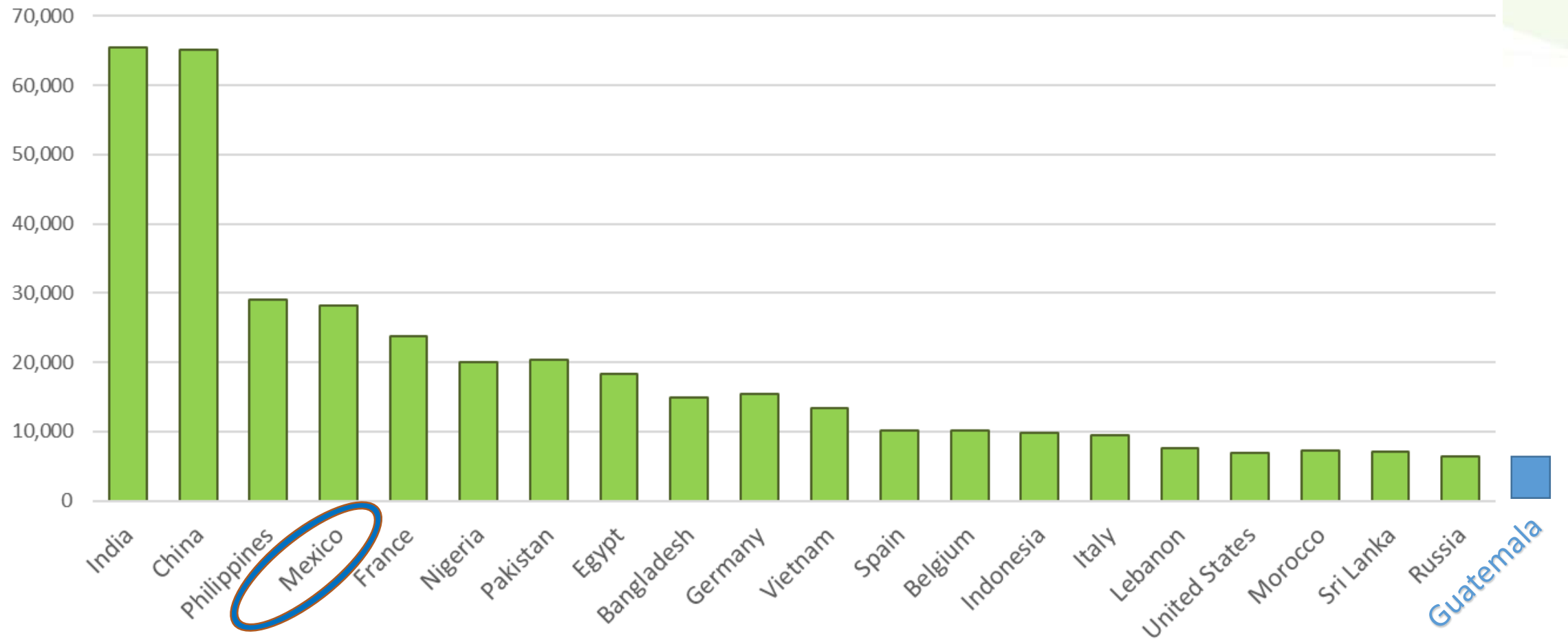

Remittances per Region 2015 (%)



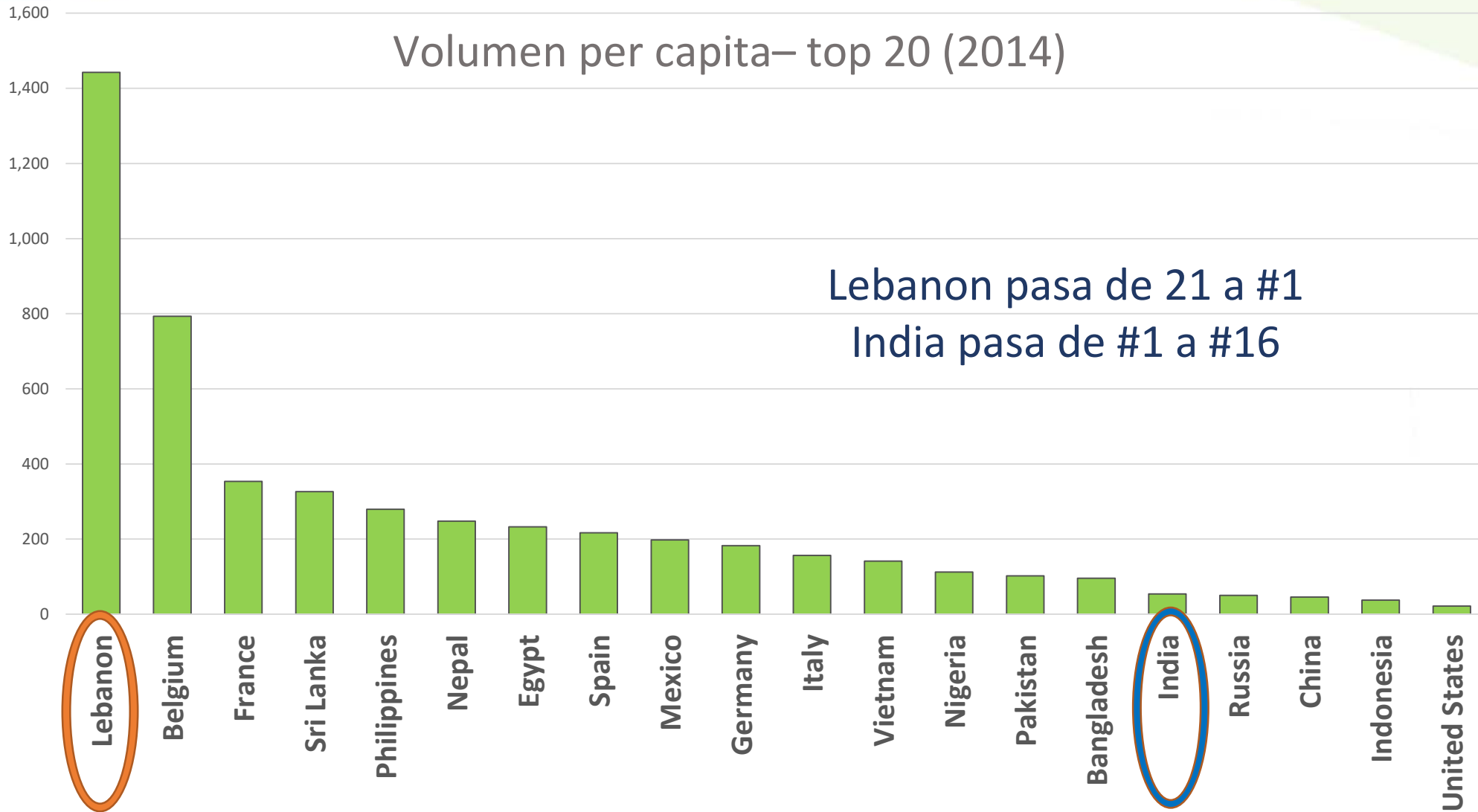
Remittance Volume per Country – top 20 inflows (2015)

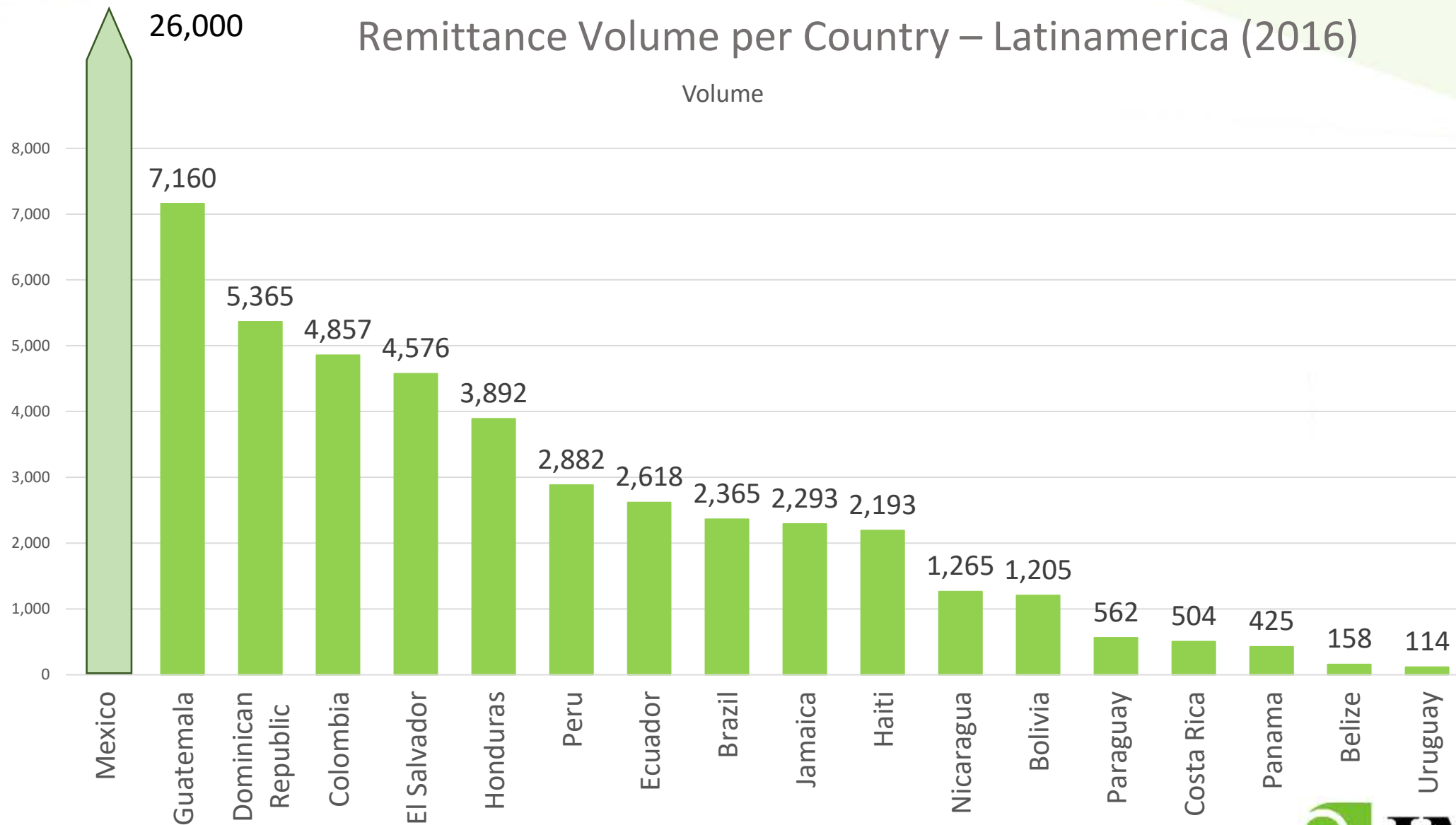
Personal Remittances, received (% of GDP - 2015)



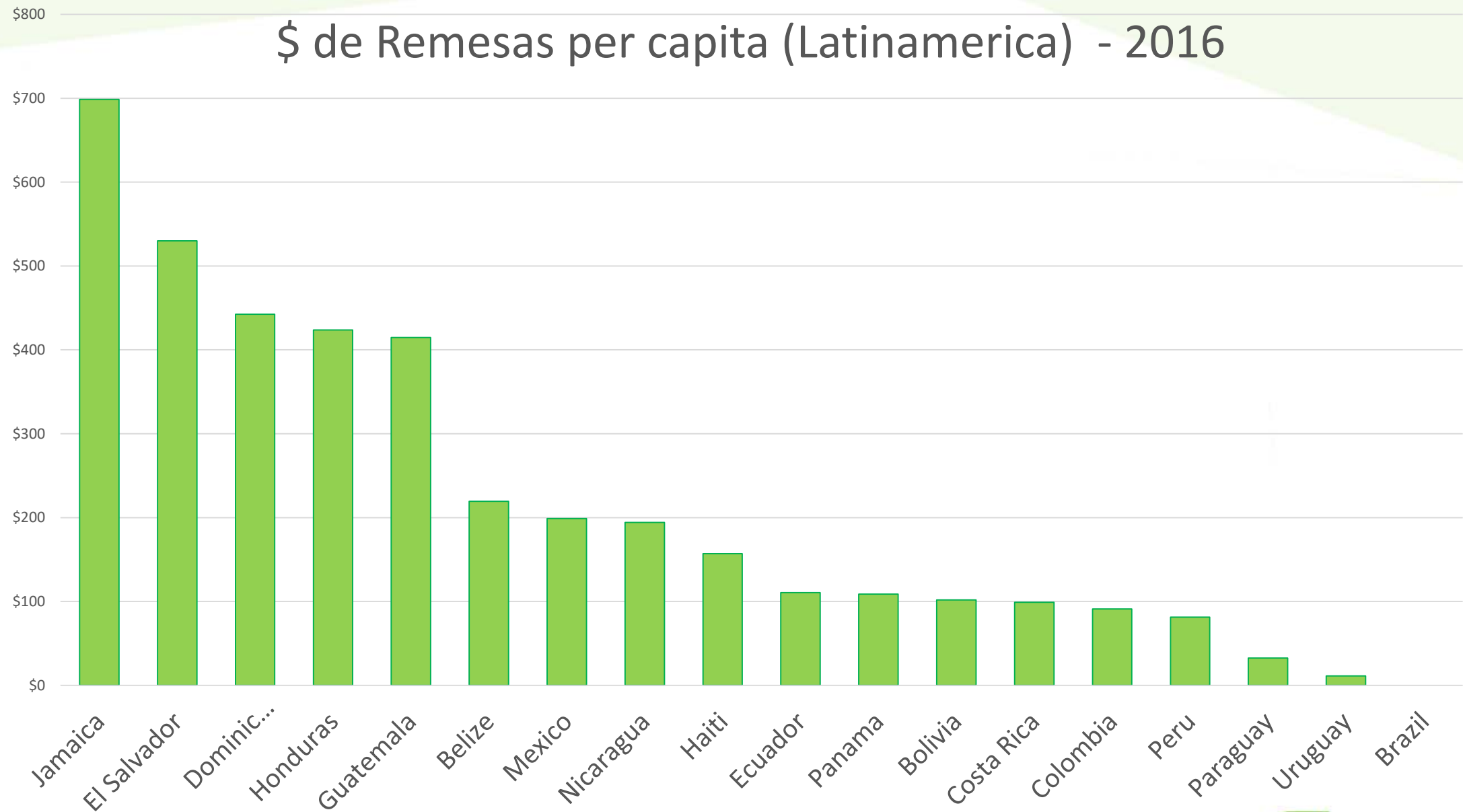

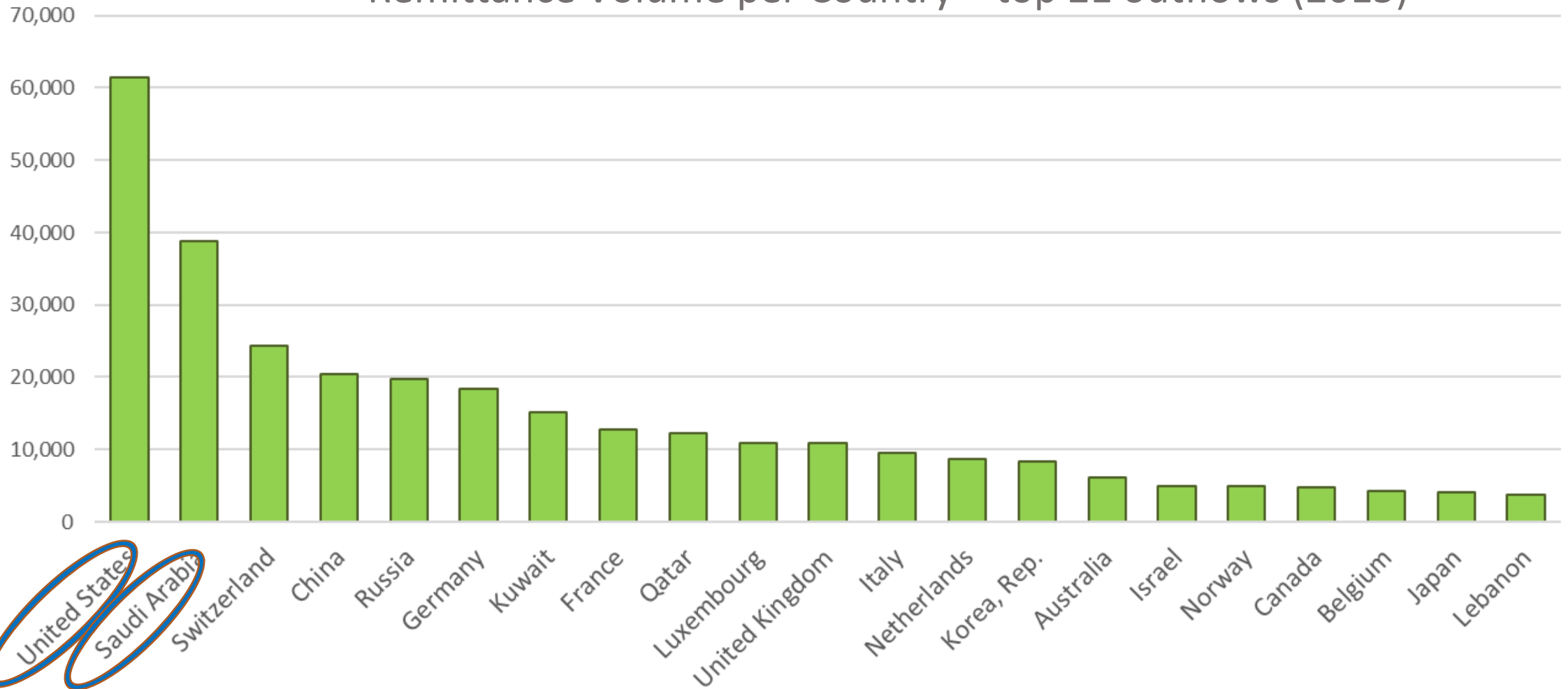
Remittance Volume per Country – Latinamerica (2016)



\$ de Remesas per capita (Latinamerica) - 2016

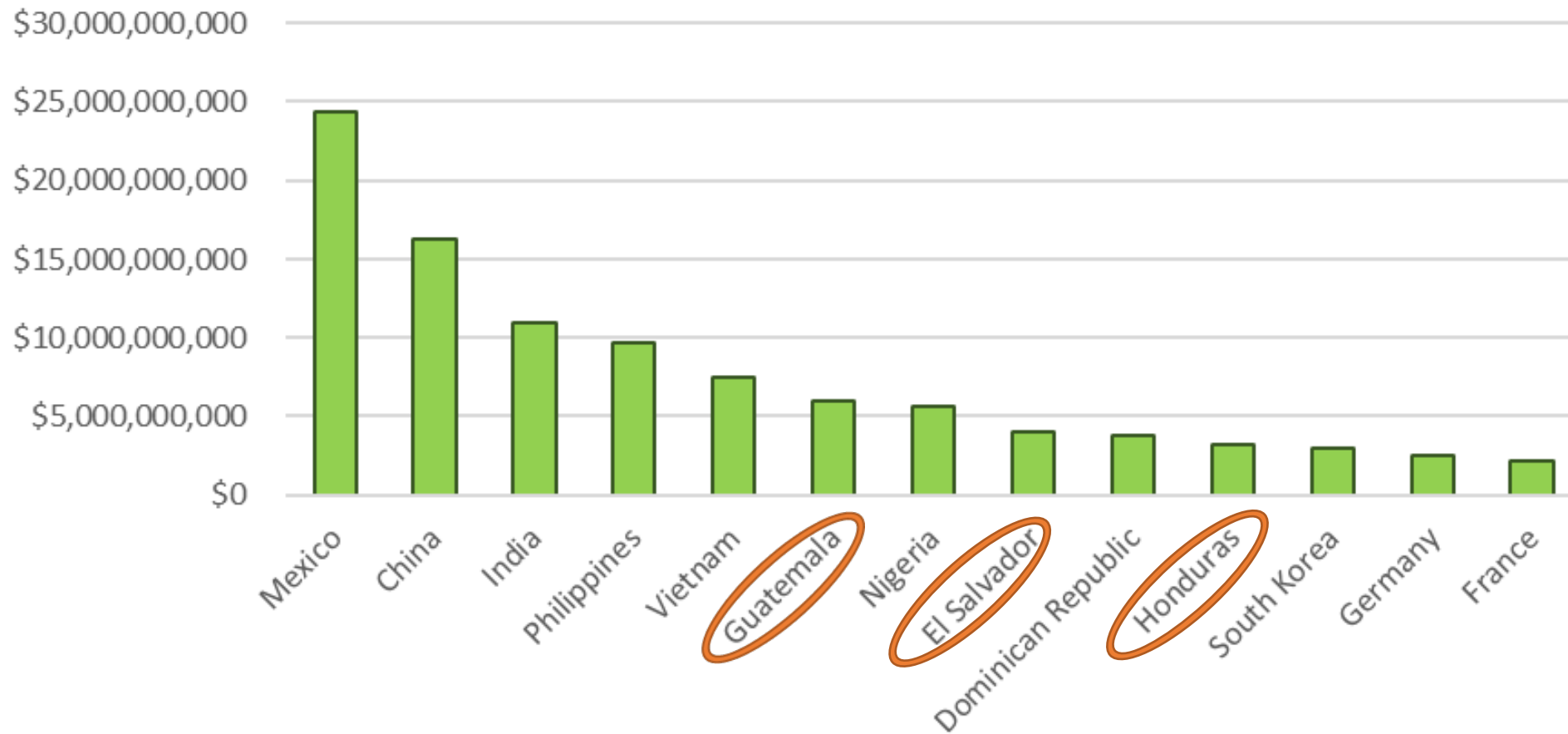


Remittance Volume per Country – top 21 outflows (2015)

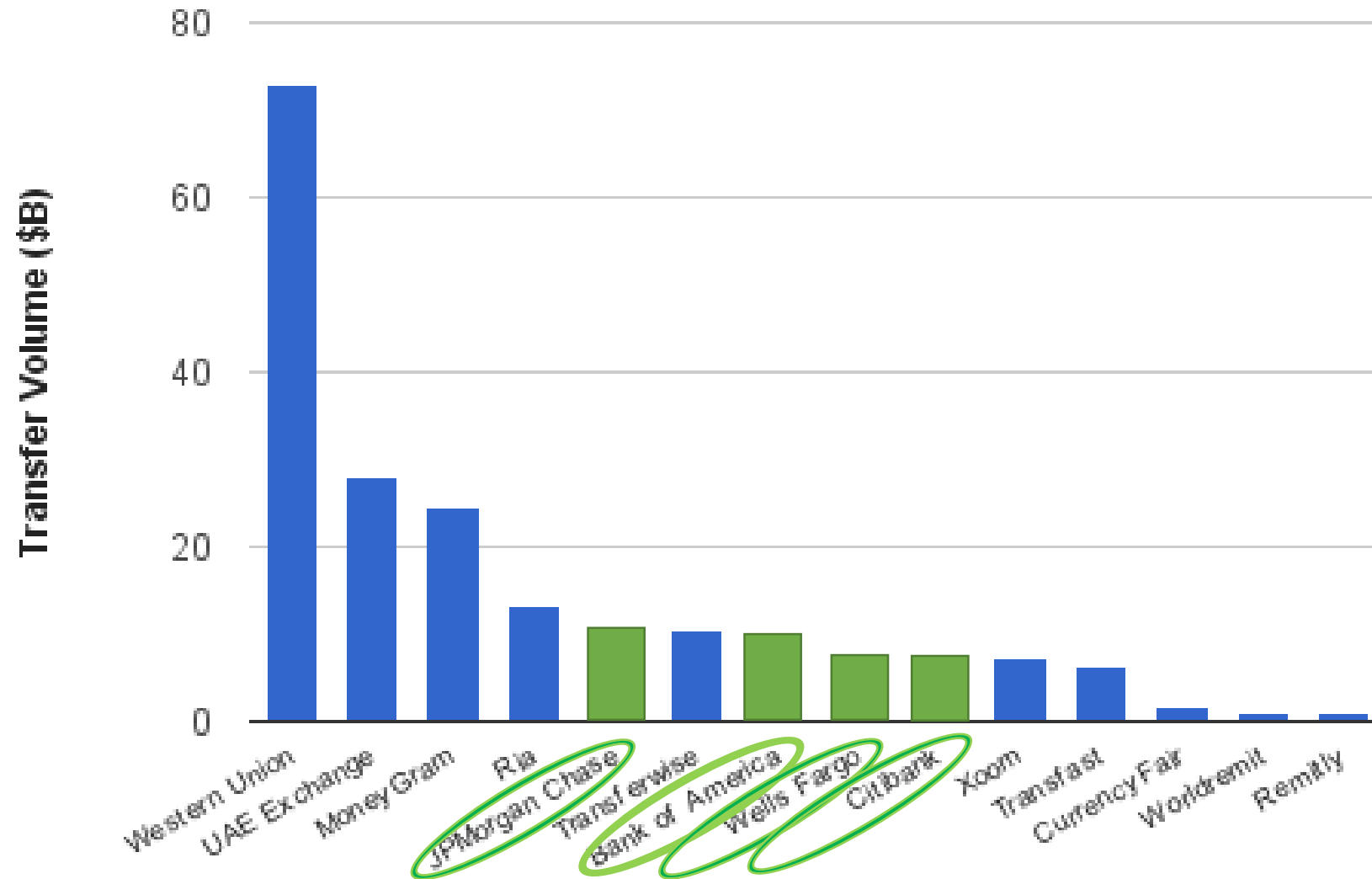
